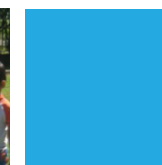

PRIMARY SUMMER CAMP

WEEKS 1-12 6/3–8/21 *Your child will have the opportunity to meet the Primary teachers and assistants, socialize and interact with new friends, learn how to appropriately achieve conflict resolution, establish Grace and Courtesy, and practice a routine that is followed throughout the school year.*

Studies include:

Ponds, Rainforests, Grasslands, Deserts and Woodlands

Students will identify plants, trees, and animals of each Biome, and the characteristics that allow them to survive in their particular Biome. Students will learn about ecosystems, including living things and non-living things. We will have picnics, walks to the river, a visitor from Sarett Nature Center, outside water activities, and a hike through Brookview's temperate forest. Children will also be introduced to (or continue working on) the Montessori materials in science, math, and language.

Sample projects include Laser Cutting and Engraving, Vinyl Cutting, Sewing, Woodshop, and 3D Printing. Please note that this camp takes place in the afternoons and is for students 8 and older. Younger students will remain at Brookview.

WEEK 5
7/1–7/3

Battle of Gettysburg with Mr. Bob

Three days that saved the nation. We were well into the American Civil War and things were looking bad for President Lincoln. He was constantly pushing his generals to get moving and stop the Confederate general Robert E. Lee. Lincoln went through several generals until he found one who might get the job done, but by then Lee was on his way to attack Washington DC. The two armies clashed at Gettysburg, PA. We will create landscape boards and trace troop movements of each day of the historic battle and see what it took to stop Lee and save the Union.

WEEK 6
7/8–7/12

Fitness Camp with Mr. Luke

Kids today don't get enough movement, or play, in their "physical diet" so it is more important than ever to get them properly educated about movement quality and how to obtain strength. This class will introduce the benefits of bodyweight exercise in a fun and challenging way. The students will strive for milestones that will keep them motivated enough to continue training and remember the lessons they learn in class. We will cover a wide variety of playful movements and calisthenics to develop physical autonomy and instill confidence.

Rock around the clock with Ms. Maggie! We will explore gems, minerals, fossils, and more. Activities will include studying the rock cycle, specimen identification, and breaking geodes.
