

Pest Advisory/Pesticide Schedule to Parents

This schedule is valid for Summer 2025 & Academic School Year of 2025-26

As part of Brookview Montessori School's Pest Management Program, pesticides are occasionally applied as a preventative health hazard, and to maintain compliancy with the Bureau of Children and Adult Licensing. As parents of a child attending Brookview, you have the right to be informed of the program. You will be notified within 48 hours through email or notes sent home in backpacks, if any of the scheduled dates change. This advisory/schedule is posted for public viewing in the front foyer of the building. In addition, the schedule will be sent to you again during the month of September, via email. This advisory will include a list of all pesticide companies that are used by Brookview Montessori School. Pesticide Company: Armor Pest Control Type(s) of Treatment: Exterior Barrier Spray

Area treated: large playground

Type of Pesticide(s) and Bifenthrin and Essentria IC

Target: Mosquitoes and Ticks

*Treatment is safe for children to be around after 30 minutes from time of application and this is done on weekends.

Tentative Dates of treatment: Scheduled dates will be the 15th of every month starting March through September of 2025. This will be treated during afterschool hours (after 5:30 pm) and on weekends. Depending on weather, these dates could change.

Pesticide Company: Rose Pest

Type(s) of treatment: Rodent Glue Boards and Interior Traps

Area treated: Throughout interior of building: classrooms, kitchen, all restrooms, common areas, boiler

room #1 and boiler room #2.

Name/Type of Pesticide: Provoke, and Soy Peanut Butter (Peanut Oil Free)

Target Pest rodents (house mouse)

Dates of Treatment: Third Wednesday of every month and as needed.

Pesticide Company-Rose Pest

Type(s) of Treatment: Sentricon Always Active System (Self contained bait stations with pesticide in the center)

Area Treated: Exterior perimeter

Description: Plastic ground inserts that are placed around exterior perimeter of building with bait stick

inside.

Name/Type of pesticide: Recruit HD

Target Pest: Termites

Dates of treatment: Monitored annually on the third Monday of June. Re-baiting on as needed basis.

Note: If re-baiting takes place, parents will be notified within 48 hours.

Pesticide Company: Rose Pest

Program: Outside Maintenance Insect Treatment (OMIT)

Type(s) of Treatment-exterior barrier spray Name/Type of pesticide: Talstar and Advance

Area's treated: Soffits, eaves, window seams, door seams, foundation walls, gable vents and perimeter of

soil barrier

Target Pest: Ants, Box Elder Bugs, Carpenter bees, Lady Beetles, Spiders, Wasps, Yellow Jackets, and

Hornets.

Dates of treatment: Fourth Wednesday for the following Months: May, July, and September for 2025

(Afterhours)

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
